Page Hospital is committed to making a difference in people's lives through excellent rehabilitative care.

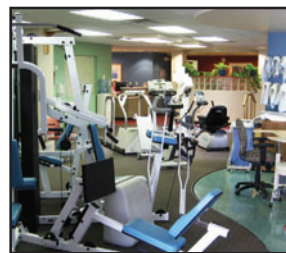

From post-operative care for orthopedic and cardiac patients to therapy designed to address specific deficits, Page Hospital serves patients with a rehabilitation program tailored to meet their individual needs.



Rehabilitation Services

Page Hospital offers an assortment of inpatient and outpatient rehabilitation services for adult and pediatric patients. From minor deficits to severe conditions affecting an individual's ability to live and function independently, the hospital cares for patients with various rehabilitative needs.



Rehabilitation services at Page Hospital include:

- **Occupational Therapy** to improve a patient's functional daily living skills including dressing, grooming and eating, as well as to improve motor, cognitive and social skills
- **Physical Therapy** to improve strength, flexibility and functional movement such as bed mobility, walking and balance, and to provide instruction on the use of assistive devices, prosthetics and wheelchairs
- **Speech Therapy**, also referred to as speech pathology, which uses special techniques to help patients improve their verbal and non-verbal communication skills, problem-solving abilities, concentration, memory and voice quality, and their ability to safely eat and drink

Support & Education

Page Hospital understands the importance of a strong support system. Each patient is assigned a case manager and/or social worker who may assist in identifying financial resources, support groups and community resources to help round out their rehabilitative care.
