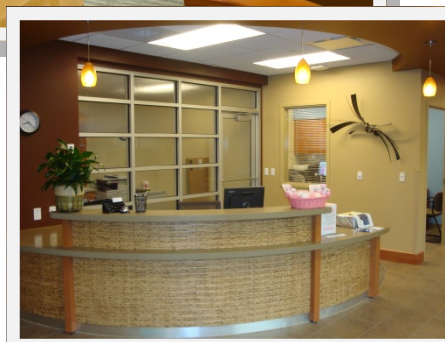

Cancer Diagnosis

Cancer treatment begins with an accurate diagnosis. At Sterling Regional MedCenter, we use a wide range of cancer detection resources and state-of-the-art medical technologies to help physicians clearly and accurately identify and stage cancers.

Cancer Treatment Options

Patients receiving cancer care at the David Walsh Cancer Center can be confident that they are getting the most current and specialized treatments available. An interdisciplinary team of experts work together to present each patient with an individualized treatment plan. The center is designed for treatment and support services to cancer patients, while still enabling them to pursue their family, work and leisure activities as much as possible. Most patients receive chemotherapy and radiation treatments on an outpatient basis.

Radiation

The radiation oncology department offers leading-edge, state-of-the-art radiation therapy and includes a Varian linear accelerator. This machine delivers radiation therapy with greater precision to the defined tumor. An experienced radiation therapy staff brings years of experience and passion for quality cancer care in northeastern Colorado.

Infusion

The Ambulatory Outpatient Infusion Center is located within the David Walsh Cancer Center. The new infusion center provides six chairs, one bed and an isolation room. The following is an example of treatment services available in the infusion center.

- Infusion - Chemotherapy, Hydrations, Antibiotics, Blood Products
- Injections - Antibiotics, Rhogam, Procrit, Lovenox, Bonevia
- Other Treatments - PICC insertions, Education for self administration, Care of all vascular ports, Blood draws from vascular ports, Pre-medicate for outpatient MRI services
