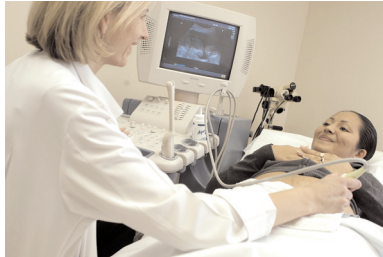

The Women's Center

The Women's Center at Banner Good Samaritan Medical Center takes a unique approach to women's health by combining academic training for obstetrics and gynecology residents with experienced board-certified faculty physicians. This allows the practice to provide advanced care for complicated women's health issues as well as routine exams. Whether you are looking for a primary care physician who understands women's health or a specialist in prenatal care, The Women's Center offers the care you need.

Banner Health, a nonprofit organization, is the preferred provider of women's health services in Maricopa County. More than 27,000 deliveries and 8,000 gynecologic procedures occur each year at our eight local acute care hospitals. It is recognized as one of the best places to work in the United States by organizations like Gallup, the American Nursing Credentialing Center and the Phoenix Business Journal.

The Women's Center is a key resource in central Phoenix. Because Banner Good Samaritan is the primary referral site for high-risk and complicated women's medical services, patients travel from all areas of the state to receive inpatient, outpatient and in-office care on our campus. Most major health insurance plans are accepted, and a sliding fee is available for qualified, low income patients.

As a teaching hospital with an obstetrics and gynecology residency program, Banner Good Samaritan can offer women the latest techniques in both routine and highly-complex conditions coupled with quality patient care. In addition, a certified nurse practitioner ensures you can always be seen in a timely manner.

Network of Care

One of the most impressive features of The Women's Center is its referral network of nationally recognized specialty physicians who treat patients at Banner Good Samaritan Medical Center. The physicians work closely with many leading obstetrical, high-risk OB and gynecological practices in central Arizona. The Women's Center is also closely connected with orthopedic surgeons, oncologists and other specialists.

Social worker and nutritionist consultations are also available to provide patients a continuum of care. When visiting the physicians at The Women's Center,

you can rest assured that no matter what your health condition, they will find you the treatment you need.

On-Site Laboratory

The Women's Center uses an on-site laboratory. For patients this means you can have most routine lab tests obtained inside the clinic. This saves time and eliminates the need for patients to make additional appointments and to travel to an outside lab for blood tests.

Insurance

The Women's Center accepts all forms of insurance and works with patients who do not have insurance to arrange payments on a sliding scale. Since this is an academic learning environment, all patients receive the highest quality care regardless of their insurance status.

The Banner Good Samaritan Obstetrics and Gynecology Residency Program and Faculty Practice is located in the Edwards Medical Plaza, Suite 407, across the street from the main hospital on the southwest corner of 12th Street and Willetta. This location is especially convenient for patients who may need to be admitted into the hospital by their physician, or who may need complex diagnostic testing.
