Banner Heart Hospital opened its doors in November 2000. First-class physicians working with an experienced staff provide the latest heart care technology in an environment of clinical excellence, compassion and healing.

This specialty heart hospital, adjacent to Banner Baywood Medical Center, has grown from 60 beds to 111 beds, making it one of the largest free-standing heart hospitals in the nation. The facility has:

- 28 cardiovascular intensive care beds
- 67 telemetry beds
- a 16-bed interventional stay unit
- a non-invasive cardiology unit

In addition to telemetry and intensive care services, this state-of-the-art facility also has:

- 6 operating room suites
- 6 cardiac catheterization labs
- 2 dedicated electrophysiology labs

The hospital has a growing medical staff of more than 450 including cardiologists, cardiovascular and vascular surgeons and other primary care and specialty physicians. Nearly 250 volunteers give their time at the hospital, as well.

Statue holds special place at Banner Heart Hospital



At Banner Heart Hospital, a unique sculpture — born out of adversity and generosity — greets all who enter the hospital's front door. Known as the Guardian, it is a statue of a woman holding a heart in her hands, yet it is much more than a piece of art. The Guardian is an important

symbol that represents the promise of our employees and physicians to make a difference in the lives of all they encounter. When one signs on to work at Banner Heart, they are signing on to be a Guardian—to live by a set of virtues that embody everything we stand for at Banner Heart Hospital:

Each year on its anniversary, Banner Heart Hospital recognizes two individuals, a physician and employee or volunteer, who exemplify these virtues, which form the foundation of the hospital's culture.
