Banner Ironwood Medical Center is located on Gantzel Road south of Combs Road in northern Pinal County, just east of Queen Creek. The hospital has 36 all private rooms with a focus on emergency services, obstetrics, surgery and general medical care.

The hospital represents a significant long term investment in medical excellence for the East Valley. The facility was designed and built to grow with the population. In fact, over 500 patient beds could eventually be built on the 80-acre campus to care for the community. The new medical center, combined with Banner's existing medical centers, creates a comprehensive network of health care services for East Valley residents.

Innovative Facility Design

Banner Ironwood's innovative design follows the footprint of Banner Health's newest hospitals, Banner Gateway Medical Center in Gilbert and Banner Estrella Medical Center in Phoenix. Evidence-based research in hospital design was used in all three hospitals to create a healing environment built to enhance patient outcomes, patient healing and patient safety.

With a canyon theme to bring the peacefulness of nature indoors and create a warm and welcoming environment, the medical center features family-friendly visitor spaces, outdoor areas and private rooms with living space for visiting families.

Patient Room Amenities

Banner Ironwood Medical Center offers large patient rooms designed to support patient healing and family involvement. A family zone includes a couch that converts to a twin bed for a family member to spend the night, an internet port and telephone. Patient education videos, games, music, movies and limited



internet access are available for patients on the interactive television system. Wireless internet access is also available. Patients are served their meals via our room service program which allows for mealtimes and menu selections based on individual preferences.

Focus on Patient Safety

Banner Ironwood Medical Center supports efficient and effective medical practice. Electronic medical records ensure state-of-the-art recordkeeping and patient care management. The architectural design includes many features that support both patient and staff safety.

The Latest Technology in Medical Care

Banner Ironwood pairs highly skilled staff with the latest medical technology to provide excellent patient care. The hospital features a unique unit licensed as a multi-organized service unit. This designation means patients can receive all levels of care from Intensive Care to general acute care in the same hospital room. These beds allow for maximum flexibility to meet individual patient needs.

This 12-bed unit is also monitored by Banner Health's iCare ICU system, which provides 24-hour remote

monitoring of patients by intensive care physicians and nurses via closed-circuit cameras and technology. *iCare* ICU staff work closely with physicians and nurses in the hospital to provide an extra level of care for patients. The adjacent 12-bed medical/surgical unit also uses this *iCare* technology to provide 24 hour monitoring by expert nurses, adding an extra level of care for patients and additional support for bedside caregivers.

Emergency Care

Our 19-bed, all private Emergency Department is well-equipped to diagnose and treat an array of illnesses and injuries. Banner Health's "Door to Doc" process ensures that patients receive the most appropriate care as quickly as possible.

Surgical Services

Four state-of-the-art surgical suites equipped with the latest surgical technology enable our medical professionals to perform a wide range of inpatient and outpatient surgeries.

Imaging Services

Banner Ironwood brings access to both inpatient and outpatient imaging services to the community. Services available include general x-ray, ultrasound, MRI, and CT.

Maternity Services

Our Women & Infants Department includes 12 postpartum beds, four Labor/Delivery/Recovery rooms, two c-section suites and a six bed nursery. Located on the second floor, this department provides a beautiful space for families to welcome their new babies.

On the Campus

A medical office building on the campus houses primary care and specialty physicians, bringing new medical services to the community.

Access to the Resources of Banner Health

As Banner Ironwood Medical Center grows, our caregivers will work closely with their peers at Banner Health's sister hospitals to ensure patients receive the specific level of care they need.

For example, children in the Emergency Department who require more specialized acute care will have access to Cardon Children's Medical Center on the Banner Desert Campus. This children's facility provides all levels of expert pediatric care. Phoenix-based Banner Health is one of the largest, nonprofit health care systems in the country. The system owns or manages 23 acute care hospitals, six long term care centers and an array of other services in seven states: Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Nebraska, Nevada and Wyoming.
