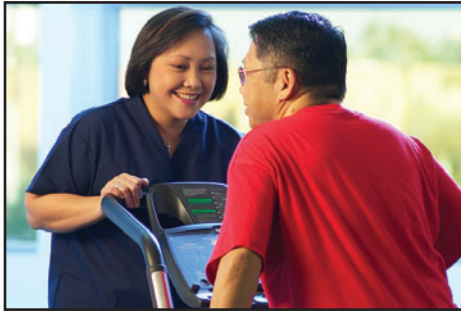

### Rehabilitation Services

North Colorado Medical Center (NCMC) is committed to making a difference in people's lives through excellent rehabilitative care. With the [Center for Acute Inpatient Rehabilitation](#) (CAIR Unit) and [North Colorado Sportsmedicine](#) (NCSM), both located on the NCMC campus, the hospital meets the varied rehabilitative needs of thousands of patients each year.

Additionally, the hospital's [Pediatric Rehab Clinic](#) addresses the special rehabilitation needs of children and adolescents with a therapy regimen and an environment specially designed for children.

An interdisciplinary team of health care professionals including physicians, nurses, therapists, social workers, case managers, dietitians and numerous support staff work together to return patients to their highest level of function as quickly and safely as possible.

From general rehabilitation and post-operative therapies to supervised exercise and sports training programs, NCMC serves patients with an array of rehabilitation needs.

#### **Center for Acute Inpatient Rehabilitation**

The Center for Acute Inpatient Rehabilitation, also known as CAIR, is a 20-bed unit specializing in rehabilitation nursing and therapy services for patients needing rehabilitative care following a stroke, brain injury, spinal cord injury, neurological trauma and/or disease, orthopedic surgery and a number of other debilitating conditions.

Services of the CAIR Unit include, but are not limited to:

- Neuropsychology
- Occupational Therapy
- Physical Therapy
- Rehabilitative Nursing
- Speech Language Pathology

Each patient is assigned a case manager and/or social worker who may assist in identifying financial resources, support groups and community resources to help round out their rehabilitative care.

#### **North Colorado Sportsmedicine**

North Colorado Sportsmedicine is located at North Colorado Medical Center and provides diagnostic, treatment and rehabilitative care for injured athletes of all ages and skill levels.

An interdisciplinary team of health care and rehabilitative professionals including on-site sports medicine physicians, physical therapists, occupational therapists and certified athletic trainers specializing in orthopedic and sports injuries work together to care for each patient.

Additionally, North Colorado Sportsmedicine offers injury prevention and performance enhancement training services using the Frappier Acceleration® Sports Training program.

With close cooperation of the clinicians, coaches and athletes our state-of-the-art motion analysis software allows this unique training program to help athletes gain speed and strength while reducing the risk of injury.

## Rehabilitation Services

In addition to services provided at the Center for Acute Inpatient Rehabilitation (CAIR) and North Colorado Sportsmedicine (NCSM), North Colorado Medical Center (NCMC) offers an assortment of inpatient and outpatient rehabilitation services tailored to the individual needs of each patient. Rehabilitation services are offered at four locations in northern Colorado including NCMC, Banner Rehab, West (west Greeley), Medical Arts Centre of Windsor and Johnstown Family Physicians.

From minor deficits to conditions affecting an individual's ability to live and function independently, NCMC cares for patients with various rehabilitative needs and provides treatment for such conditions as:

- Arthritis
- Aqua therapy
- Brain Injuries
- Chronic Pain
- Hand and Orthopedic Injuries/Conditions
- Industrial Injuries
- Lymphedema
- Spinal Cord Injuries
- Stroke
- Women's Health

Other common rehabilitation services offered at NCMC include:

- **Occupational Therapy** to improve a patient's functional daily living skills including dressing, grooming and eating, as well as to improve motor, cognitive and social skills, and provide instruction on the use of adaptive equipment that may make daily task easier
- **Physical Therapy** to improve strength, flexibility and functional movement such as bed mobility, walking and balance, as well as provide instruction on the use of assistive devices, prosthetics and wheelchairs. Aqua therapy is provided at our west Greeley location.
- **Speech Therapy**, also referred to as speech pathology, which uses special techniques to help patients improve their verbal and non-verbal communication skills, problem-solving abilities, concentration, memory and voice quality, and their ability to safely eat and drink

## Pediatric Rehab Clinic

The Pediatric Rehab Clinic at North Colorado Medical Center is dedicated to providing highly-specialized, family-centered pediatric rehabilitation services in an environment that caters to the special needs of children and adolescents.

The clinic provides inpatient and outpatient care, developmental intervention in the nursery. The clinic also provides an assortment of parent support and education resources.

The Pediatric Rehab Clinic specializes in:

- **Physical Therapy** to help children with developmental delays, range-of-motion limitations, strength/muscle weakness, balance difficulties and abnormal tone with the goal of promoting functional gross motor skills
- **Occupational Therapy** to help children develop age-appropriate skills through play while addressing self-help skills, fine and gross motor skills, sensory processing skills and hand-writing skills
- **Speech Therapy/Speech-Language Pathology** to help children with articulation, language, voice, stuttering, feeding and/or swallowing disorders and difficulties while focusing on all forms of communication including speaking, listening, reading, writing and cognitive development
- **Audiology** to provide newborn hearing screenings, follow-up evaluations, diagnostic testing and hearing aid fitting, and evaluations for children and adolescents
- **Pediatric Feeding & Swallowing Program** to help infants and children overcome such feeding difficulties as reflux, breast/bottle feeding difficulties, failure to thrive, poor volume, food aversions and self-feeding difficulties
