### **Education and support**

Platte County Memorial Hospital offers a number of classes and support groups, including those for childbirth. These birthing classes are held three times per year in January, May and September. Classes are free and consist of six, two-hour classes that run for six consecutive weeks. Parents-to-be can learn what to expect during pregnancy as well as the birthing process, and each class offers various relaxation techniques to help make labor as comfortable as possible.
