Banner Good Samaritan Medical Center in downtown Phoenix has provided care to our Arizona community since 1911, and is a flagship hospital within Banner

Health. Nearly 1,700 physicians representing more than 50 specialties work with Banner Good Samaritan staff to care for more than 36,000 inpatients a year. Banner Good Samaritan operates more than 650 licensed patient care beds.

Banner Good Samaritan is a teaching hospital that trains nearly 250 new physicians annually, and is a premier medical center offering the highest level of care to the most critically ill patients in Arizona and the Southwest. The hospital provides a comprehensive foundation of general medical/surgical programs as well as many highly specialized programs that are not widely available in community hospitals. Excellent patient care and service are the hallmarks of programs like such as the Harry J. Cavanagh Cardiology Center, Level I Trauma care, cancer care, and general and minimally-invasive surgery. Highly specialized services, such as solid organ transplantation, high-risk obstetrics, blood conservation medicine, a movement disorders clinic and the positron emission tomography center, have emerged as leading programs in our region and beyond.

Banner Good Samaritan physicians and staff rely on leading-edge technologies in the care of patients. Additionally, Banner Good Samaritan has become a recognized research center in selected areas of medicine such as Alzheimer's disease and spinal cord injuries.

Banner Good Samaritan serves the community through important programs like the Banner Good Samaritan Poison Control Center and the Outpatient Clinic. Many

hospital physicians and nurses participate in outreach programs, traveling to rural health centers around Arizona to deliver patient care, and instructing health care professionals in advanced medical techniques.

Banner Good Samaritan has been named a Magnet hospital for nursing excellence by the American Nurses Credentialing Center, has been cited year after year as one of America's "Best Hospitals" by *U.S. News & World Report* and is preferred by consumers and physicians for quality of care and clinical leadership.

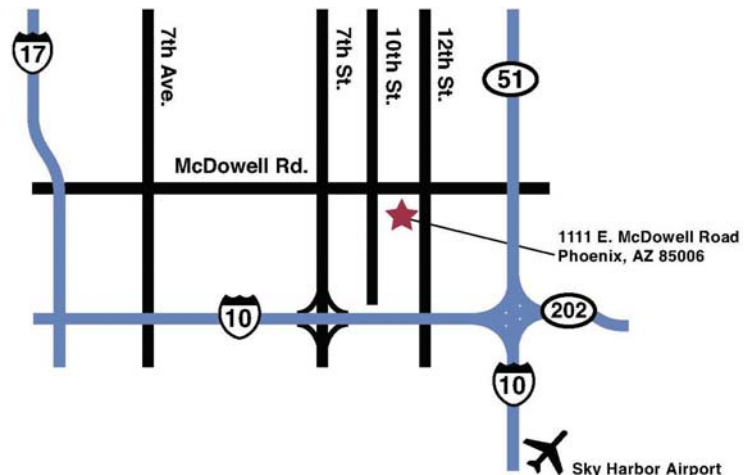
