### What is Magnet™?

The Magnet™ Program is a prestigious status awarded to health care organizations in recognition of nursing excellence.

### Nursing Excellence

Banner Good Samaritan Medical Center was awarded the coveted seal of approval in June 2005 from the

American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC), the credentialing arm of the American Nurses Association. Banner Good Samaritan is ranked among the nation's leading health care facilities for nursing care.

### Magnet™ designation

Of more than 6,000 hospitals nationwide, fewer than 300 have earned Magnet™ status to date—a four-year designation by the ANCC. With more than 1,000 nursing professionals serving an estimated 36,000 inpatients annually, it is the largest and longest serving medical center in Arizona to hold the honor.
