- Cancer Care – Patients have access to state-of-the art diagnostics and treatment options through the McKee Cancer Center and an inpatient oncology unit.
• Women’s Services – Services include McKee’s Family Birthing Center, which offers the latest in obstetrical care; McKee Breast Center; Women First Certified Nurse-Midwives, McKee Center for Women’s Health and Healthy Beginnings/Prenatal Plus program, which serves underinsured and uninsured women in the community.
• Emergency Care – The new Emergency Department opened in 2007 with 17 private patient rooms. Staff aims to have patients seen by a health care provider in less than 30 minutes.
• Heart Care – Offering a broad range of cardiac services including a catheterization lab and cardiac rehabilitation programs.

Community Health Programs

- **Healthy Beginnings/Prenatal Plus Program:** This community-based prenatal program assists expectant mothers who have little or no insurance coverage. The program helps women access quality prenatal care and education.
- **KidSelf Pediatric Therapy:** KidSelf serves young children who experience physical, developmental and communication difficulties and whose parents do not have insurance coverage or are unable to afford the cost of physical, occupational and speech and language therapies for their child.
- **Loveland Community Health Center:** McKee partners with Sunrise Community Clinic of Greeley to provide health care for uninsured or underinsured community members. McKee provides the physical facility, expansion and supplies.
- **Organizer of Loveland Community Health Fair:** More than 1,400 people participate in health screenings and learning more about healthy living.
- **Relay for Life:** McKee sponsors the local charity walk to benefit the American Cancer Society.
- **Sponsor of P.A.R.T.Y. (Prevent Alcohol and Risk-Related Trauma in Youth):** This program provides local high school students with education regarding the effects of alcohol use and risk-taking behavior.
- **Prescription Assistance Program:** Elderly and low-income community members receive aid in accessing assistance for their prescription medication.
- **COPD (Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disorder), Heart Failure and Asthma education classes:** McKee provides these classes for community members.
- **Turkey Trot:** McKee sponsors this annual 5K run/walk and 1-mile kids' fun run on Thanksgiving Day with more than 1,000 participants. The race benefits pediatric and cardiac rehabilitation programs.

- The McKee cafeteria is licensed by the Larimer County Health Department and the Colorado Health Department and accredited by The Joint Commission.
- McKee Women's First Certified Nurse-Midwives is accredited by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.
- McKee Cancer Center has been designated a Community Cancer Program by the American College of Surgeons Commission on Cancer.
