Surgical Care Unit

Banner Del E. Webb has 12 operating rooms, including four minimally invasive surgery suites and two surgical suites specially equipped for orthopedic implants.

We use such surgical technologies as:

- Fluoroscopy
- GPS navigation technology (orthopedics)
- X-ray capability during surgery
- PACS (fully digital medical imaging system)

The hospital's new preoperative and recovery area provides space for patients and their loved ones and allows hospital staff to provide supportive, healing care. A bright and airy nearby waiting area overlooking our Reflection Garden provides a comfortable place for families during a loved one's surgery. Private consultation rooms are available for families to meet with physicians following surgery.

Family-Centered Patient-Care

Our surgical staff focuses on a proactive approach to quality patient care that includes communication and education. From the time the patient begins preparing for surgery through the time the patient is recovering, our team emphasizes a family-centered approach to help ease any anxiety a patient may have.

Managing Your Pain

We strive to provide as painless a surgical experience as possible. However, it is likely that patients will experience some discomfort following surgery.

At Banner Del E. Webb, our anesthesiologists and certified RN anesthetists can employ a number of methods to keep pain levels to an acceptable level that will allow a patient to participate in therapy and enjoy some needed rest.

Operative and post-operative pain management methods available at Banner Del E. Webb include:

- General anesthesia
- Regional anesthetic blocks
- Epidural pain management and single spinal injections
- Patient-controlled analgesia (PCA) via a personal medication pump

Patients are encouraged to discuss these pain management options with their surgeon and anesthesiologist.

The evening before your surgery:

- Ask your physician about special instructions for the morning of your surgery.
- Bring a list of your medications, dosages and times of day that you need to take them.
- Follow any pre-surgery instructions given to you by your physician.
- Notify your physician if a cold, fever or other infection develops before your surgery.
- Do not eat or drink anything according to physician's instructions, including water, throat lozenges or chewing gum. Your surgery could be cancelled if you eat or drink without special instructions.
- If you smoke, your physician will instruct you on when to refrain from smoking prior to surgery. Smoking can irritate the lungs and contribute to nausea.

The day of surgery:

- Take a bath or shower the day of your surgery. Do not wear makeup, hairpins, lotion, powder or perfume. You may brush your teeth but be careful not to swallow any water.
- Bring your own personal hygiene items, such as robe, slippers, etc., to make yourself as comfortable as possible.
- The hospital suggests you leave valuables such as money, credit cards and jewelry at home as the facility is not responsible for misplaced or stolen items. However, patients may require cash, credit card or check for their co-payment or deductible. After payment is made, please give valuables to family or friends to return home.
- If you wear contact lenses, glasses or dentures, bring a case or container to protect them.
- Be prepared to show your health insurance card. If you have an Advance Directive, Living Will or Medical Power of Attorney, bring a copy.
- Wear comfortable, loose fitting clothing that is easy to take off and put on. Your clothes will be given to a family member or friend, or placed in a secure room with your name and brought to you after surgery.
- Feel free to ask about concerns. An informed patient is a more relaxed patient.
