The lab staff at Summit View consists of a dedicated team of three phlebotomists and one medical technologist.

The lab personnel are responsible for performing the following diagnostic tests:

- Blood Draws - All ages, including pediatric and neonatal patients
- EKG - All ages, including pediatric and neonatal patients
- Strep Screens/Throat Cultures
- Glucose Tolerance Tests
- Gestational Screens
- Newborn Screens - PKU test and supplemental screening
- Giving out specimen collection containers (also a drop-off site for specimen collections)
- Bleeding Time

Special Instructions

- If your test requires you to fast, DO NOT eat or drink anything for a minimum of 12 hours prior to the test.
- Water is acceptable
- Medications are acceptable unless otherwise

specified by your physician

- Tests that are not run at the Summit View specimen lab are routinely sent over to the NCMC lab to be run in a timely fashion.

- Cortisol Stimulation, call (970) 350-6100
- Sweat Chloride, call (970) 350-6412
- Semen Analysis
