Patient navigator helps identify resources, meet needs

The Patient Navigator Program offers support programs and services to cancer patients, family members and caregivers. These free services consist of general information about site-specific cancer, community programs, transportation, and temporary lodging for cancer patients and their families.

If you are a cancer patient receiving treatment at Banner Baywood, the Patient Navigator can help you:

- By providing literature on coping with cancer, what to expect during chemotherapy and radiation, and dealing with side effects of treatment.
 - By referring you to support groups, classes, and other programs for information and support.
 - By helping you identify resources for financial assistance, medication needs, home healthcare, insurance questions, transportation and other concerns.
 - By listening, caring and helping you in your time of need.
- By identifying activities that can help ensure a better quality of life.
 - By helping cancer survivors learn to self-navigate.
