Behavioral Health Center

Patients and their families who turn to the Behavioral Health Center at Banner Good Samaritan can be assured that they will receive excellent patient care in a safe and compassionate environment. The experienced mental health professionals of the Behavioral Health Center treat adults and older teenagers in outpatient and inpatient settings.

The Behavioral Health Center staff includes six board-certified psychiatrists, doctoral level psychologists, master's level counselors, therapists, social workers, nurses and 18 psychiatry residents. Our behavioral health professionals are supported by Arizona's leading provider of hospital services, Banner Good Samaritan Medical Center, where there are nearly 1,600 medical specialists on staff.

A 22-bed secured unit is available on the sixth floor of the hospital's West Tower



for patients 18-years and older requiring hospitalization.

Our inpatients receive a thorough medical and psychiatric assessment, followed by rapid stabilization of symptoms. This is done in an environment that is both medically sophisticated and humanistic. Couple and family participation are encouraged when appropriate and include counseling and education regarding mental and emotional illness.

The Behavioral Health Center's Outpatient Clinic is a key resource in the central Phoenix area. Nearly 7,000 outpatient visits occur annually. Most major health insurance plans are accepted and a sliding scale fee program is available for qualified patients who are seen through the fully-accredited Psychiatry residency program.
