McKee Medical Center is dedicated to providing innovative, compassionate orthopedic services tailored to meet the individual needs of its patients.

The field of orthopedic medicine encompasses all aspects of the musculoskeletal system, and McKee Medical Center treats an array of adult and pediatric conditions ranging from sports-related and emergency injuries to arthritic, congenital and degenerative conditions affecting the bones, joints, muscles, ligaments, tendons and cartilage.

From diagnosis to treatment and rehabilitation, McKee Medical Center cares for patients through all stages of the orthopedic care process.

Orthopedic Diagnosis

Orthopedic medicine encompasses the entire musculoskeletal system, and there are countless conditions for which patients seek orthopedic care.

Common orthopedic conditions treated at McKee Medical Center include:

- Arthritic Conditions
- Back, Neck and Spine Conditions
- Carpal Tunnel Syndrome
- Congenital Deformities – conditions present at birth
- Degenerative Joint Conditions
- Fractures



- Hand and Foot Conditions
- Ligament Injuries

We utilize a number of diagnostic procedures and imaging technologies to identify and evaluate orthopedic conditions including:

- Arthrography – a radio graphic examination of a joint
- Computerized Tomography (CT)
- Ergonomic Assessments
- Functional Capacity Evaluations
- Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI)
- Myelography – a radiographic examination of the spinal canal and nerve roots
- Ultrasound

Treatment Options

Patients receiving orthopedic care at McKee Medical Center can be confident that they are getting the most current and specialized treatments available. A multidisciplinary team of experts works together to present each patient with an individualized treatment plan.

Common orthopedic procedures performed at McKee Medical Center include:

- Ankle Replacements
- Arthroscopic Surgery
- Hand and Foot Surgeries
- Partial and Total Hip, Joint, Knee and Rotator Cuff/Shoulder Replacements
- Reconstructive and Spinal Surgeries
- Sports-related procedures including ACL (Anterior Cruciate Ligament) Repair

Orthopedic surgeons providing services at McKee are complemented by highly-skilled registered nurses specifically trained in the care of orthopedic patients.

Expertly skilled in state-of-the-art pain management, McKee staff uses such pain management practices as sacroiliac joint injections (SI injections), nerve root blocks and more.

The hospital also provides an inpatient rehabilitation gym where physical and occupational therapists work to help orthopedic patients regain the ability to complete the functions of daily living.

Support & Education

McKee Medical Center understands the importance of a strong support system and provides an array of support and education resources to help orthopedic patients feel confident that they are receiving excellent medical care.



To ensure patients are comfortable with both their diagnosis and proposed treatment, the hospital offers a complimentary Total Joint Education class for patients preparing to undergo total knee and/or total hip replacement surgery. This program is coordinated through the patient's physician office as part of the surgery scheduling process. Please contact your physician's office to schedule the Total Joint Education class.

McKee Medical Center also offers Osteoporosis Bone Density testing using low-cost ultrasound screening to determine whether a person is at risk for developing osteoporosis.
