Banner Churchill Community Hospital is committed to providing compassionate, innovative cancer care services tailored to meet the individual needs of its patients. Through the hospital's Outpatient Infusion Center, patients receive excellent chemotherapy care in a convenient and comfortable manner.

Managed by a nationally certified oncology nurse and staffed by nurses certified in chemotherapy services, the Infusion Center at Banner Churchill offers an array of treatments including Chemotherapy; Blood transfusions; Biotherapy; Injections, including Neupogen and Epogen; Intravenous (IV) Antibiotics; Hydration and Electrolyte Replacement; Peripherally Inserted Central Catheter (PICC) Placement; and Care of Long Term Central Catheters.

#### Cancer Diagnosis

Cancer treatment begins with an accurate diagnosis, and Banner Churchill utilizes a number of cancer detection resources and state-of-the-art medical technologies to identify and stage cancers.

Banner Churchill offers such cancer diagnostic



resources as: Colorectal Screening, Computer-assisted Diagnosis (CAD), Computed Tomography (CT), Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI), Mammography, Ultrasound and more.

Banner Churchill's cancer treatment services include: Advanced Surgical Services; Management of Treatment-related Side Effects; Pain Management; Sentinel Node Biopsy; Out-patient Chemotherapy; and Treatment and care for benign and malignant hematological disorders.
