- Advocate if hospitalized and assist with misconceptions
- Offer education of disease and new therapies
- Assist with referrals to specialist or establishing with primary providers

WHAT TO EXPECT

Our team includes a Nurse Practitioner, Registered Nurses, and a Medical Assistant. Our services include full access to the hospital amenities including laboratory, pharmacy, imaging, respiratory, music therapy, pet therapy, and chaplain services. Our treatment area features nine private paitent treatment bays equipped with oxygen, heart and pulse oxygen monitor equipment, television, reclining chairs, a blanket warmer, heat packs, and a box lunch.

A visit to our clinic starts with meeting our Nurse Practitioner. The nurses will use an ultrasound to place peripheral access or sterile technique to access your port. Blood samples are collected to determine the severity of your pain crisis and proper treatment. Your therapy may vary from 4 hours or up to 10 hours depending on your blood results, symptoms, and pain levels.

If you are experiencing a pain crisis (vascular occlusive crisis) or symptoms of severe tiredness (anemia), we require that you have someone bring you to our clinic and arrange a ride home. We do not want you driving with severe pain or anemia on the day of treatment. We can help you arrange transport services with your insurance.

Our clients appreciate the personalized care, being able to manage their disease without hospitalizations, receiving therapy from a team that understands their disease and offers compassion.
