

Complying with the Copyright Laws when distributing copies of articles

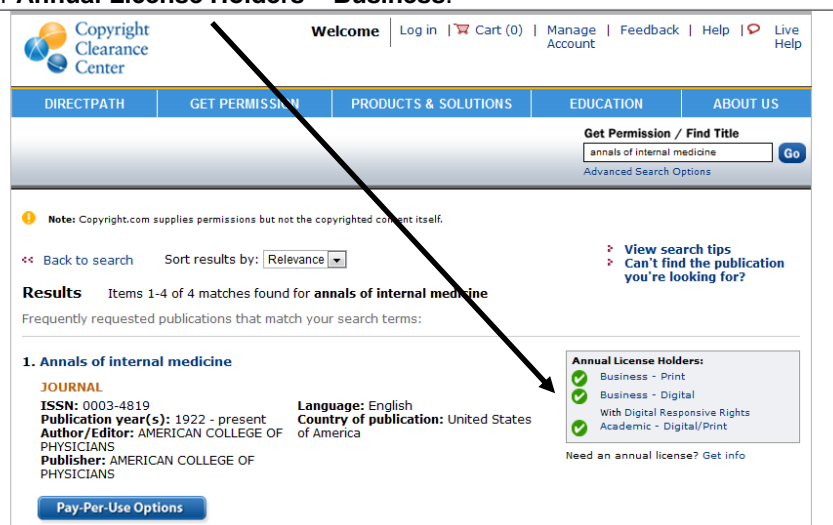
Banner has a system-wide annual business license with the Copyright Clearance Center (CCC), which allows us to distribute print and/or electronic copies of copyrighted materials covered by the license. A search of their database (<http://www.copyright.com/>) will show you the permissions for any journal.

You must request permission from the journal for any journal or use not covered by the CCC license. Checking the journal website is a good place to start the "permission request" process.

A. Search for the journal title.



B. Check information under Annual License Holders – Business.



In this case, you can distribute paper copies of the *Annals* articles within Banner as well as distribute/post an electronic version within Banner. A URL link to the article can be distributed or posted if no permission is indicated.

C. Permissions for a journal may vary by date, like *JAMA* below. Click on **Verify Coverage** to search the publication year of the article you want to use, which will display permissions:
