

Geriatrics

Training in geriatrics is provided through longitudinal curriculum during the three years. This includes experience in preventive and general medical care in hospital, outpatient and long-term care settings. Each resident has several long-term care patients s/he follows at area nursing homes with faculty input. Nursing home rounds are conducted on a monthly basis with faculty supervision and multidisciplinary roundtable discussions to enhance the learning experience as well as patient care. Home visits on geriatric patients are also included in the curriculum. Additionally, a portion of the didactic curriculum is devoted to geriatrics.
