

## How to Meet Banner Health Immunization Requirements

**\*Subject to other specific test or Health Standard as Banner Health may request from time to time\***

### MMR (Measles/Rubeola, Mumps, & Rubella):

- I. Documentation of positive IgG titer for Measles/Rubeola, Mumps and Rubella. *Choose this option if you had all three illnesses OR you have received the vaccinations but have no documented proof.*
  - If any of the titer results are NEGATIVE or EQUIVOCAL, you must get your first MMR vaccination and provide proof of documentation. The second MMR must be completed after 28 days and documentation submitted.
- II. Documentation of completion of one series of MMR immunizations. *One “series” of immunizations includes two immunizations for each disease on separate dates at least 28 days apart.*

### Varicella (chickenpox)

- I. Documentation of positive IgG titer for Varicella. *Choose this option if you had chicken pox OR you have received the vaccinations but have no documented proof.*
  - If any of the titer results are NEGATIVE or EQUIVOCAL, you must provide proof of your first Varicella vaccination and documentation of the second vaccination completed 30 days later.
- II. Documentation of completion of one series of Varicella immunizations. *One “series” of immunizations includes two immunizations 30 days apart.*

### Tuberculosis (TB)

Annual Documentation of TB free status is required; documentation must cover your entire rotation.

- I. Documentation of completion of a negative Two-Step TB Skin Test. *Two-Step TB Skin Test consists of an initial TB skin test and a boosted TB skin test 1-3 weeks following the first test.*
  - If results are POSITIVE, you must provide documentation of a clear chest X-ray or negative IGRA test.
- II. Documentation of completion of a negative Two-Step TB Skin Test and recent annual testing.
- III. Documentation of a negative chest X-ray **and** annual documentation of a TB disease-free status by completing a Tuberculosis Screening Questionnaire.
- IV. Documentation of a recent negative result from an IGRA test (Quantiferon, T-Spot).

### Hepatitis B

- I. Documentation of positive HbsAB titer. *Choose this option if you have received the vaccinations but have no documented proof.*
- II. Documentation of completion of one series of Hepatitis B immunizations. *One “series” of Hepatitis B immunizations includes three injections, an initial injection followed by a second injection given 1 to 2 months after the first dose and a third injection 4 to 6 months after the first.*
- III. Signed Declination form.

**Influenza Vaccine:** Required for any student whose rotation will occur one or more days during the flu season, *December 1-March 31.*

- I. Documentation of recent immunization
- II. Signed medical or religious exemption form. *This will require that a mask be worn during the designated flu season.*

**It is recommended for personal safety and protection that Students receive the following immunizations:**

### Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis (Tdap):

- I. A one-time adult dose of Tdap (age 19 or older), followed by a Td booster every 10 years.  
*Tdap = Tetanus / Diphtheria / Pertussis, Td = Tetanus / Diphtheria*
