Pet Therapy Program

Under the supervision of Banner University Medical Center (BUMC) staff or Volunteer Resources, the Pet Therapy volunteers (handler and dog) can visit patients, families, visitors and staff as needed or requested in designated or unrestricted areas within the facility. They provide comfort, distraction, and peace through gentle companionship and have assigned shifts and times. They also provide excellent customer service while maintaining the confidentiality of patients, visitors, volunteers, and employees of BUMC. These services are provided within the guidelines of The Pet Therapy Policy set by Banner Health.

Teens Teaming Up, the summer teen program, launches each year during June. Teens between 15 years old and 18 years old serve at both the Main and South campuses, Diamond Children's, the Toy Store, the Children's Library, and the Gift Shops. The program typically begins during early June and runs until the end of July.
