

Community Medicine

Community medicine is incorporated into multiple areas of the curriculum. The residency provides care for a significant proportion of the underserved patients who are admitted to the hospital, including adult medicine, pediatrics, and maternity care. Residents also participate in care for the underserved population in various outpatient settings: the NCFM Family Medicine Center, Sunrise Community Health Center, the Weld County Health Department (consult clinic during Women's Healthcare rotation), Monfort Children's clinic (Outpatient Pediatrics rotation). Other activities (incorporated into various rotations) include working with a school nurse, school based clinics, touring the local meat-packing plants and their on-site occupational clinic, migrant farm worker mobile clinic, TAR WARS, "Doc of the Day" at the Colorado state legislature, performing pre-participation physicals for various community organizations, environmental health site visits, self-study modules on epidemiology, volunteering at Health Fairs, and more.
