

Moonlighting

Second and third-year residents have numerous opportunities to moonlight, though the residency does not require moonlighting. Residents have the opportunity to work weekends in small towns in northeastern Colorado, and also can work in local minor care and urgent care centers on weeknights. Malpractice insurance is provided by the program for moonlighting at locations that are pre-approved. Program requirements state that residents must obtain medical licenses in their second year, which affords them a wide range of opportunities for moonlighting.
