Breakfast – 7 a.m. to 9 a.m. every Tuesday and Wednesday

- **Pancake Breakfast - \$2.50**
- **Belgian Waffle Breakfast - \$3.00**

Both breakfasts served with scrambled eggs, bacon or sausage and juice. Breakfast is open to anyone in the community.

Congregate (Dining Room) Meals

Hot, delicious meals served in the Senior Center's dining room Monday through Friday - \$4.00 suggested donation.

Reservations required 24 hours in advance.

Curbside and Take-Out Meals

Order a meal to take home either from the dining room or drive-up. Participants can drive in, park in a designated area and meals will be delivered to their car. **Meal pick-up time is 10:45-11 a.m. The cost is \$4.50 per meal. Reservations required 24 hours in advance.**



Home-Delivered Meal Program

The Center delivers hot, nutritious meals to homebound seniors Monday through Friday. ***A case manager determines eligibility.***

Mobile Meals Program

Two meals delivered Monday through Friday: one hot meal and one sack lunch plus milk, juice, dessert, fruit, bread and snacks. **The cost is \$8 per day (one person) or \$7 per person for two. Mobile Meals are only available to Sun City and Youngtown residents.**

Pantry/Food Bank

Helps offset food expenses and supplement nutritional needs. Registered members of the Center can visit our Food Bank daily and take home a bag of bread, pastries, fruit, vegetables or any other items available that day.

The fourth Friday of every month, the Center offers a Mobile Pantry to all members of the community providing a variety of food items from seasonal produce to breads.
