- We encourage all visitors to wash their hands when they first enter the room and after any contact. Hand sanitizer is conveniently located throughout our facility, please feel free to use routinely.
- Visitation by children under age 12 is on a case-by-case basis. Please contact staff to make arrangements.

- To protect our patients, please refrain from visiting if you are ill, have a cough or fever.
- Visitation of patients in isolation depends on the patient's condition. Please be aware of precautions, you may be required to wear a gown, mask, and gloves. If you are not sure or unable to follow these precautions, staff will assist you.

Courtesy cart service to and from your vehicle is available in most parking areas. Please visit our Volunteer Services desk located at the main public entrances for assistance.






Visitor's Guide and Map
